#### HMS BOARD OF DIRECTORS NOMINATION PROCESS IS OPEN FOR SUBMITTALS

## **Overview of Available Board Positions**

The Hazardous Materials Society (HMS) is looking for the best and brightest to lead the organization forward. A total of **THREE** (3) **DIRECTOR** positions are open with a three-year term, beginning on January 1, 2023, and ending on December 31, 2025. The maximum number of years any candidate may serve is six (6) years.

These positions are open to ANY IHMM-certificant, who is in good standing with the Hazardous Materials society (HMS) as well as the Institute of Hazardous Materials Managers (IHMM). Self-nominations are permitted.

# **Nomination Eligibility**

Review the following eligibility requirements. Assuming both nominator and nominee qualify, then a nominating form will need to be completed and submitted electronically.

#### **Nominator**

- 1. Self-nominations are allowed as long as they meet the items discussed below.
- 2. The nominator may not be a current member of the HMS Nominating Committee.
- 3. ANY IHMM-certificant is eligible to be nominated for the open positions.
- 4. The primary nominator must be an HMS member AND an IHMM-certificants in good standing with the IHMM.
- 5. Additional nominators are allowed. Additional nominators are not required to be IHMM-certificants. There is a limit of three (3) nominators per nominee.
- 6. Only one nominator may be from the same organization as the nominee's primary place of employment.
- 7. The nominator must provide thorough written and verifiable evidence of the demonstrated professional contributions in both of two defined areas, as well as meet the other requirements noted below. The two defined areas are excellence in science or profession and outstanding service to IHMM, IHMM certifications and/or HMS.
- 8. Nomination materials will only be accepted in electronic format. The electronic submittal must include all requested materials to be considered.

## **Nominee**

- 1. The nominee must be an IHMM-certificants in good standing with both the HMS and IHMM.
- 2. Nominees **may not** be current members of the IHMM Board of Directors, AHMP (Alliance for Hazardous Materials Professionals), or serve as a member of a National Board or a chair of a committee of any other national non-profit organization whose role, purposes, foundation, or work is involved in the health, safety, environmental, or hazardous materials field.
- 3. Must agree to have a background check.
- 4. Must be willing to sign the HMS Code of Ethics and HMS confidentiality agreement.
- 5. Must be in good standing with the IHMM in all certifications.
- 6. Agree to attend all electronic meetings which are currently held monthly on the third Monday. There is an annual meeting which may also be held in electronic format.
