Chris has been a CHMM since 2009 having spent most of his early career focused on CERCLA and RCRA in the US Southeast, US Midwest, Europe, and the Bahamas. He has been an RPM on NPL sites primarily related to clean up of military industrial reserve and ordnance plants that supported WWII efforts. Chris has conducted Phase 1&2 ESAs, EIS's, multi-media facility auditing, and was the PRP lead for the military in forty Southeast states.

Chris managed an Environmental Job Order Contract in the Chicago Area for five years across fifteen Midwest states performing a wide variety of

environmental related projects from harbor dredging to hospital hvac system cleaning, sewer relining, asbestos and lead abatement, mercury spill clean ups, large scale demolition, UST removals, and range remediation. He has been responsible for day-to-day management of hazardous materials and wastes at a variety of military and commercial facilities.

He also managed large scale military material and waste management during Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003-2004.
